Your hunt cost is \$ _____. A 50% deposit is due upon booking with the remaining 50% plus a \$1000 charter fee (your final payment of \$ _____) is due 60 days in advance of the hunt by **check or wire transfer** (all check payments are to be made out to The Bush Pilot, Inc.). Or if you like you can wire your final payment, at least 30 days prior to your arrival in Alaska, using this information: Wells Fargo Bank, P.O. Box 509, Soldotna, Alaska 99669; Phone (907) 262-4435; Routing or Swift #102000076; Account #1101098937 (The Bush Pilot Inc.).

Hunting packages start and end in the field and hunters are responsible for all airfare to and from the field. This includes booking your commercial flight into Kenai, and paying us in advance for the charter flight between Kenai and the field. This charter flight is usually \$1000. Hunters are also responsible for any hotel costs before and after the hunt (\$100.00 - \$200.00 per night). If, for any reason, you need to leave camp early there may be an additional charge by the charter service to come and pick you up.

The hunting package provides food & lodging while in the field, transportation to spike camps, guide, skinning, packing, and field care of trophies. Trophy care upon reaching Kenai is done through our expediter at hunters expense and responsibility.

You need to arrive in Kenai, at the latest, no later then the day before your flight to the field. If you arrive during business hours we will meet you at the Kenai Airport, help you with your transfer to the hotel, and assist you with any shopping needs. If you arrive late at night we kindly ask you to take the hotel shuttle bus or taxi to your hotel, which will already be booked for you. An assistant will meet you the next morning. Make sure there is time for these purchases if needed before you leave for the field.

An additional tip of \$300/per animal for wolf, wolverine, caribou & black bear and \$500—\$1000/per animal for moose, grizzly, & brown bear for your guide is customary and greatly appreciated.
